What does EPSDT mean for my child?

E

The E stands for Early

Many sicknesses can be stopped before they start or stopped before they get worse. Immunizations, (the shots kids get to keep them from getting certain diseases) medical and dental checkups can stop health problems early.

P

The P stands for Periodic

Periodic means regular. Regular check-ups are important to make sure kids are growing well and to make sure no new problems have developed.

S

The S stands for Screenings

Screenings are tests that are done to check for health problems. One type of screening is a blood lead test. Remember that blood lead tests must be completed twice by your child's 2nd birthday.

D

The D stands for Diagnosis

If something unusual is found during a screening or test, the doctor studies it further and makes a diagnosis. The diagnosis reveals what the doctor thinks the symptoms and test results show.

T

The T stands for Treatment

Treatment controls or cures the diagnosed health problem. When the health problem is controlled, it does not get any worse. When the health problem is cured, it goes away completely.

- Full physical exam
- Growth and development check
- Health education
- Hearing and vision screenings
- Health education for parents and youth
- Oral health assessments
- Lab testing (including blood lead tests)
- Mental health checks
- Treatment or service referral
